



Credit and Debit Card Safety Record

Much of the information regarding your credit and debit cards is in your billfold already, but you may have to find information from your credit card issuers to fill in addresses and telephone numbers. (Never keep PINs [personal identification numbers] in your billfold.) Try to keep this record up to date. If you should lose a credit or debit card, this information will be very helpful to you. But make sure that you keep this Safety Record in a safe place where no one can access it. You want to make sure you guard your identity carefully!
